EQUINE FACILITY RELEASE OF LEGAL RIGHTS FOR EVENTING CAMP

1. **Acknowledgement of risk:** the undersigned acknowledges that horse training, horseback riding, and other equestrian activities ("Activities") are dangerous activities and that participating as a contestant, a rider, and employee, a volunteer, a spectator, day camp attendee, or otherwise, exposes the participant to substantial and serious risk of property damage, personal injury or death. The undersigned expressly acknowledges that this/her participation in any Activities will involve such a hazard and the undersigned hereby accepts all such hazards and risks. The undersigned hereby assumes all hazards and risks associated with the physical condition and other conditions related to the Property and livestock on the Property. Owner and trainer make no representations or warranties of any kind, express or implied, regarding the condition of safety of the property, any livestock thereon, any Activities or any other matter
2. **Release:** The undersigned, being fully aware that participation in any Activities will expose him/her to a serious risk of property damage and or personal injury or death, hereby fully releases and forever discharges Brooke Phillips; Owner of Willamette Sport Horses, LLC; in addition to owners of Caber Farm, owners agents and employees and Owners heirs, personal representative, successors and assigns (collectively released parties), from all liability for any and all property damage, personal injuries, death and other claims arising from the undersigned's participation in or observance of the Activities at the property or any acts or omissions of the Released Parties, including those that are known or unknown, foreseen or unforeseen, future or contingent.
